LEAP = Lighthouse Educational Adventure Program – Students who want to get the 0.5 credit for LEAP activities next year will need to enroll in the "class" in Sycamore and pay a fee of \$150. The fee covers the cost of all of the LEAP activities and campout for the year. Please note that the end-of-the-year trip is not a LEAP activity and is not included in the fee. Other students who do not wish to earn the credit that year can still sign up and pay for individual activities and campout. At the end of the year, students wishing to receive the LEAP credit must turn in the required paperwork.

SI = Semester Intensive – 1 year of material is covered in one semester. One credit is earned for the semester long course.

DE = <u>D</u>ual <u>E</u>nrollment – A Lighthouse teacher prepares the students for the college course, acts as a tutor during the college course time, and provides a Christian worldview even if the textbook is secular. Class is led and graded by the college professor. Students earn college credit and high school credit. Enrollment in the college course is required for enrollment in the high school course. Students register for the course through Lighthouse AND enroll in the course through the college. Additional fees are paid directly to the college.

DC = <u>D</u>ual <u>C</u>redit – A Lighthouse teacher instructs, grades the work, and provides a Christian worldview even if the textbook is secular. Students earn college credit and high school credit; students are not required to earn college credit. Students register for the course through Lighthouse AND enroll in the course through the college. Additional fees are paid directly to the college.

CLEP = College – Level Education Program – A Lighthouse teacher instructs, grades the work, and provides a Christian worldview even if the textbook is secular. Following completion of the course, students may opt to take the CLEP Examination through the College Board. Successfully completing the Lighthouse course does not guarantee passage of the CLEP exam nor does it cover the cost of the exam itself. Students are responsible for registering, paying, and taking the exam.

EQUIP – Equip is required for all students who are planning to graduate from Lighthouse and is an important part of the Lighthouse central classroom days. Equip is a part of our counseling curriculum, and sessions address personal, social, spiritual, academic, and career development. Mondays will include a combination of chapel, small groups, and worship. Wednesdays will a time for activities relating to college, career, and community. On Fridays students will participate in a club of their choosing.

Eligibility for High School Athletics – As we are now a part of MCSAA (Missouri Christian Schools Athletics Association), there may be elibility requirements for some of our high school sports. Please see the handbook for eligibility criteria or contact the Athletic Director at Ipaeagles@lpajc.com.
